

MONSOON PLANTATION DRIVE



Date: July 28, 2018

The Monsoon Plantation Drive organized by Sri Krishna Dutt Academy aimed to contribute to environmental conservation and beautification efforts along the Lucknow-Raibareli Road to Mohanlalganj area. - Understanding the challenges posed by population growth on socio-economic development.
- Advocating for family planning and reproductive health services as essential components of population control.
- Promoting education and women's empowerment as key strategies for reducing fertility rates.
